

Abernethy United Methodist Church

In-person worship helpful instructions.



We strongly advise arriving early so the screening can be completed prior to entering and social distancing can be maintained.

1. Masks are required to attend the worship service. The mask must properly cover both your nose and mouth.
2. At this time we ask all of our congregation members and visitors utilize only the front door of the Sanctuary to enter. Please do not enter through the side or back doors of the church.
3. Touchless sanitizer will be in the narthex and we ask you to use it each time before entering the Sanctuary. A volunteer will ask to take your temperature with a touchless monitor.
4. Our volunteers will give you a bulletin as you enter.
5. Please use only the center aisle to find a seat, starting at the front of the Sanctuary.
6. Volunteers will help you find a seat if needed. Pews are blocked off for social distancing. You will need to keep six feet from anyone who is not in the same household. **Please limit one household per pew.**
7. At the conclusion of services, volunteers will direct your exit through the **center aisle, starting at the rear** of the church (staying socially distant) and avoid a bottleneck at the door. Please do not use the side aisles.
8. Once outside, please step away from the door to allow for the proper social distancing and for room for others to pass.
9. Please note our service will look a little different than in the past. The worship committee has made adjustments to our service for the safety of everyone attending.
10. An offering box will be in the narthex which can be utilized before and after the worship service. If you need an envelope to mark your offering please ask a volunteer.
11. Remember to bring the following: A mask (Required), your Bible, and a water bottle if you wish. There will be no access to a water fountain. The restrooms will be open.
12. If you are not feeling well we respectfully ask for the health and safety of others that you stay home with to avoid contact with other congregation members.
13. We understand at this time there are many with health conditions and concerns and may be unsure if it is right to attend the worship service. Abernethy will continue to offer the services on a CD while we transition to a new pastor and music director.
